Overview

A comprehensive one-year course to enable candidates to gain proficiency and take on senior managerial roles in primary care at scale. The course is designed for people working in primary care networks including the primary care home model and GP super practices. The curriculum will incorporate the learning and experience from NAPC's primary care home programme and the new care models programme.

What you can expect

- A practical, online, service development and business management diploma
- Learn from current primary care at scale developments
- Qualifications – gain 60 credits (20 per module) at postgraduate level 7. On completion of the diploma, students may apply to study for HFMA's Higher Diploma which provides a pathway to a full MBA to a full MBA awarded by BPP University. A post-graduate certificate providing 60 credits in the Credit Accumulation Transfer Scheme (CATS) is planned

Fees

Total fee: £2,800 + VAT
