Overview

A comprehensive one-year course to enable candidates to gain proficiency and take on senior managerial roles in primary care networks (PCNs). The course is designed for people working in PCNs including the primary care home model – an advanced primary care network. The curriculum incorporates the learning and experience from NAPC's primary care home programme and the new care models programme.

What you can expect

- A practical, online, service development and business management diploma
- Tailormade course for primary care networks
- Qualifications – gain 60 credits (20 per module) at postgraduate level 7. On completion of the diploma, students may apply to study for HFMA's Higher Diploma which provides a pathway to a full MBA awarded by BPP University. A post-graduate certificate providing 60 credits in the Credit Accumulation Transfer Scheme (CATS) is planned

Fees

Total fee: £2,800 + VAT

Registration fee: £280 + VAT (payable as a deposit on notification of candidate acceptance, non-refundable).

Candidates can take all three modules separately – subject to the availability of places. The cost for taking one module is £1,200 + VAT.
